Day 1 *(Arriving previous day)*

9am

Qantas Founders Museum

9am Stockman's Hall of Fame Museum - open until 5pm
(The Stockman's hall of Fame proudly displays the history behind some of Australia's greatest and bravest explorers, stock workers, pastoralist, and Aborigines. The exhibits comprising an eclectic mix of objects, images, touch screens, audio-visual presentations and open displays, allowing visitors to interpret the outback story in their own unique way. The museum also houses a vast reserve collection which forms a unique work-in-progress display. From behind a glass wall, visitors can view archival material, photographs, artworks and various other items used for research and in new display development.)
